

JUNIOR FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COURSE

This January the School of Medicine will again offer a four month career development course designed especially for junior faculty. Featuring a diverse faculty selected from throughout the School of Medicine, Goizueta Business School and the Ethics Center, this course will present a large body of information necessary for academic success in a variety of formats including didactic presentations, panel discussions, group and individual exercises, and case-based problem solving. Since space is limited in this course, we encourage early nominations.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:

All **full-time instructors and assistant professors** in the School of Medicine.

HOW TO APPLY:

We will consider nominations directly from applicants or from departmental chairs. In either event, the enclosed application form should be filled out and must include a brief statement from the candidate as to how the course will assist them in their careers. There is no limit to the number of nominations from a department, but final selections will take into account representation from many departments and will be limited to 25-30 individuals. **The deadline for applications is November 9, 2007.**

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT

The course encompasses 10 3-hour sessions to be held twice monthly from January to early May. Nine sessions will meet on Thursday afternoon from 5-8 PM (dinner included) with one optional Saturday morning writing workshop. The majority of sessions will take place in Emory University Hospital. **Faculty accepted to the program are expected to make every effort to attend all sessions.**

WHAT IS THE COST OF THE PROGRAM

There is no cost to faculty or departments for this program.
